When: Friday, July 31 Evening JAM (6:00pm-10:00pm)
Saturday, Aug 1 All Day BOIL & JAM (10:30am-Dusk)
We'll pause to eat about 12:30pm

Location: Red Top Mountain State Park on Lake Allatoona - Historic Log Cabin. Follow the paved walk from the Park Lodge to the Cabin at the lake

Directions: I-75 Exit 285 Red Top Mountain. Turn Right off Exit, approx. 2 miles, cross lake bridge, follow signs to Red Top Park Lodge (Approximately 11 mi. North of I-575/Town Center/Kennesaw State Univ Approximately 3 mi. South Cartersville Exit)

We Provide: The Low Country Boil pot, veggies, seasonings, (and the pot watchers) tea, ice, plates, napkins, utensils

What to Bring:

- ❖ Peeled shrimp and smoked kielbasa "offerings" are needed for the Boil!!
- ❖ A side salad/dessert/drink for the pot-luck.

Note: when you arrive, take your shrimp/kielbasa contributions to the pot-cookers and put the rest in the cabin on the sharing table

Additional Notes:

- ❖ Your significant others are welcome to partake in the Boil and pot-luck. They can fish the nearby lake, stroll or hike the Red Top Park paths. Red top Restaurant is also open.
- ❖ Make it a day trip, or stay at Red Top State Park campground, Lodge room, or cabin.
- ❖ During the course of the day, we'll have porch jams; AND folks can spread out around the cabin yard for smaller group jams / sharing circles.
