## About the Tablature...

It's March, so this month's tab pays homage to a new month that includes an Irish holiday, *"Brian Boru's March."* 

This song is a traditional Irish tune about the High King of Ireland from about 941-1014AD. Brian Boru died in the Battle of Clontarf in which his army defeated the Vikings. This tune was originally a slow air but is now usually played as a faster march. Some think this may be the oldest fiddle tune.

Brian Boru's fame was so great that the princes descended from him, the O'Briens, subsequently ranked as one of the chief dynastic families of the country.



Brian Boru is celebrated as a patron of the arts and is often thought to have played the harp. The Brian Boru harp is the national symbol of Ireland, pictured on Ireland's coins and many national badges and symbols. It has been displayed in Trinity College for over 200 years. It is one of the oldest surviving Gaelic harps and it is covered in fine and intricate carved and colored decoration.

Another fun fact: Both the Queen of England and the Duchess of Wales can trace their ancestry to Brian Boru.


# **Dalton Dulcimers**



### Brian Boru's March -







Brian Boru (c. 941 – 23 April 1014, Old Irish: Brian Bóruma mac Cennétig; Middle Irish: Brian Bóruma; modern Irish: Brian Bóroimhe) was an Irish king who ended the domination of the High Kingship of Ireland by the Uí Néill. Building on the achievements of his father, Cennétig mac Lorcain, and especially his elder brother, Mathgamain, Brian first made himself King of Munster, then subjugated Leinster, making himself ruler of the south of Ireland. He is the founder of the O'Brien dynasty.
